

According to the French statistics institution (INSEE), the consumer price index increased by 4.8 percent year-on-year in March 2022 (compared with 4.5 percent in March, 3.6 percent in February and 2.9 percent in January 2022). Increased energy costs are again the main contributor to inflation. Food inflation was at 3.8 percent, while fresh food inflation was at 6.6 percent. Rising costs are having an obvious effect on purchasing power, with overall food consumption in France down by 2.5 percent in value year-on-year in March. The commercial restaurant sector will no doubt suffer also as they are obliged to reflect the rising cost of supplies in menu prices. The situation in other European countries is similar to France.

Fish prices that had spiked sharply during the Easter period came down somewhat in May, but remain very much ahead of last year's price levels.

GROUNDFISH

Cod supply is expected to decline in 2022. Prices are going up at the moment, and are expected to increase even further. Cured cod prices are stable at high levels, but this period of the year is period of high consumption for these types of products.



Index for prices



TUNA - BILLFISHES

Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific (WCP) has improved to moderate-to-good. Carriers in the WCP are filling up quickly and an increase in landings in Thailand is expected. With the improvement in fishing, skipjack prices have fallen somewhat. However, the downward slide may be limited by the high bunker prices and operating costs, and also the upcoming 3-month FAD-closure which starts on 1 July.

TUNA - Pacific Ocean




Catch rates in the Indian Ocean have slowed to slow-to-moderate. Fishing effort has also decreased with several boats now tied up due to high fuel prices, operating costs and concerns about the yellowfin quota. Despite the reduction in catches, skipjack prices have fallen while yellowfin prices continue to increase.

Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean continues to improve and is now at the moderate-to-good level. Similarly, there has been improvement in raw material inventories at local canneries. Some volumes are now being exported to other markets. Skipjack and yellowfin prices continue to increase.


Fishing in the Eastern Pacific Ocean has also improved to moderate-to-good. Carriers continue to arrive from other markets. With the increase in fish landings, skipjack prices have fallen below the prevailing Bangkok level. Yellowfin prices have also decreased.

With the improvement in supply, European prices for skipjack have fallen. However, demand for yellowfin is still high and prices continue to increase. Meanwhile, the indicative price for cooked, single cleaned skipjack loins remains stable.

TUNA - Spanish canneries




CEPHALOPODS

Octopus is in very low supply in the European market, and prices are increasing sharply. For some sizes, the price increase since the beginning of the year has been 50 percent and more. Traders are afraid that these price hikes will put octopus out of reach of the average European consumer.

The South African squid season re-opens on 1 July. There is virtually nothing in stock. Prices for the little squid available reached record levels of EUR 11.00 per kg for the larger sizes. Because the local currency is weak, foreign revenue is higher when converted to local currency, but shipping expenses are also higher than before COVID-19.

SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa




CRUSTACEANS

Argentina has reported good catches during the Northern shrimp campaign, although fishing costs are very high. At the same time, coldstorage holdings are good in Europe, while demand is declining after the strong Easter trade, and these conditions are leading to slightly lower shrimp prices.


Crab and lobster sales have been boosted by the reopening of full service restaurants and the removal of vaccination certificate requirements in key markets.

There is some price tension due to lower supply at present, before the full fishing season kicks off. As in other industries, producers must grapple with general inflation due to higher fuel and other operational costs both at sea and on land.

CRAB - in France, origin: Europe




Lobster prices have also increased due to a lack of stocks as the new season is yet to start.

BIVALVES

With the end of the French Bouchot mussel season there is greater availability of Spanish rope mussels and Dutch bottom mussels. Rungis wholesale selling prices for products from Spain and Italy increased by EUR 0.40 per kg in mid-April, pointing to pressure on supply. Wholesale price increases are quite unusual, and a 20 percent price increase in just one month is an important event. Rungis prices for Dutch mussels have also increased since March, but less than the Spanish and Italian products. It is also important to note the increased availability of 1 kg retail trays this year compared with the traditional 1.4 kg tray, reflecting tighter supply.

MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France




In the oyster market, higher input costs such as wood for baskets, energy and labour have led to price tension.

SMALL PELAGICS

Norway has set a unilateral quota for Northeast Atlantic mackerel that increases the country's national catch by 106 456 tonnes to 298 299 tonnes. This strong increase is likely to result in lower mackerel prices on the world market. In fact, import prices of mackerel into Italy are already declining.

Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France




Norwegian exports of frozen mackerel were USD 124 million in the first three months of 2022, a 20 percent decline from the corresponding 2021 level. The unit value of frozen mackerel exports rose by the same percentage.

FRESHWATER

Frozen pangasius fillet imports into Spain recovered in the opening months of 2022. In the first two months of the year some 811 tonnes were imported, 100 tonnes more than in the same period of 2021. During the same period, the unit value went up to USD 3.40 per kg, compared with USD 2.65 per kg one year earlier. Pangasius prices also rose in other EU countries, particularly in Italy, which is another major consumer of this species.


Pangasius - in Italy, origin: Viet Nam



Salmon

European prices for Atlantic salmon are soaring, reaching levels not seen in some 40 years. The Fish Pool Index reached NOK 122.02 per kg in week 18, compared with NOK 65.83 per kg in the same week last year. The key factors behind these exceptional price levels are booming demand driven by the post-pandemic recovery, tight early year supply and spiking input and freight costs. As the foodservice reopening continues across the continent, restaurants are still facing some difficulties recovering to pre-pandemic levels of business due to labour shortages and high costs, but in combination with buoyant retail demand these additional sales channels are nevertheless propelling prices skyward.

Fish is also been made relatively more scarce by the increased prevalence of winter sores at Norwegian farms, which requires that harvested fish be downgraded in quality. While farmers are generating good margins despite higher costs, processors are getting squeezed by lack of raw material supply on top of the extremely high raw material prices. According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), Norway exported 82 500 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 8.1 billion in April, which is an increase of 43 percent compared with April last year in spite of a 3 percent drop in volume. This is another record-breaking month for the Norwegian industry, the latest in a succession of multiple broken records in recent times. High shipping costs to Asian markets reportedly remain a challenge, but household consumption in core EU markets is driving strong demand growth. In the UK, salmon export prices have risen in line with their Norwegian counterparts, reaching GBP 9.40 per kg in week 20, compared with



GBP 5.70 per kg in the same week last year. Scottish salmon farmers have also been reporting spiking input costs, and continuing freight issues. Calls have been repeated for the streamlining of UK-EU trade in the wake of Brexit.

At current price levels, farmer margins will remain good despite the cost inflation that is also being felt. Although some decline from current peak prices is expected, global supply growth this year is unlikely to be sufficient to bring prices back to the levels observed in recent years. At Fish Pool, Norwegian forward contracts were closing at levels ranging from the mid-NOK 80s (USD 8.80) to the mid-NOK 70s (USD 7.75) per kg for the remainder of the year, with the lowest observed in the traditional post-summer harvesting period. The forecasted increased of 1-2 percent in Norwegian harvests and 4-6 percent in Chile in 2022 are far below the levels needed to keep prices around 2021 levels given the market conditions we are now observing. At the same time, however, the Ukraine conflict and the political and economic upheaval remains a significant source of uncertainty that could contribute to further cost increases and reshuffling of trade routes and trading relationships.


TROUT

Trout supply out of Norway remains tight in early 2022, and prices are climbing as a result. According to the NSC, Norway exported 3 400 tonnes of trout worth NOK 317 million in April, reflecting a decrease of 9 percent and an increase of 31 percent respectively. The important trout markets of Belarus and Ukraine have been directly affected by the war in Ukraine but Thailand, the USA and Japan have generated more than enough demand to lift prices. In week 18, prices for fresh head-on-gutted trout reached NOK 105.69 per kg, comparable to salmon and a 72 percent increase relative to the same week last year.

SEABASS SEABREAM

Prices for farmed European seabass were significantly higher than the seasonal norm in April 2022, with Greek 300-450 g fresh fish selling for EUR 5.50 per kg on the Italian market. Meanwhile, prices for Greek 300-450 g Gilthead seabream on the Italian market remained stable at EUR 4.70 per kg.

Production of both species is set to increase moderately in 2022, but supply growth has slowed significantly relative to the rapid expansion seen prior to the pandemic. In Turkey, there has been a renewed focus on more restrained production planning in order to maintain sustainable price levels and Turkish export prices of both species have risen as a result. In week 17, Turkey exported 4 000 tonnes of fresh seabream to the EU at an average unit value of EUR 4.85 per kg, while the equivalent figure for fresh bass was EUR 5.80 per kg.
