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# EUROPEAN PRICE REPORT

## Latest trends

From Holy week and Easter, the main consumption period for fishery products in Europe, is being celebrated early this year. Traders are stocking up quickly, as cold storage holdings in Europe are low for all major products. This strong demand is leading to higher prices in all leading markets. Notably, shrimp has suddenly regained popularity, after bleak demand which had characterized the whole of 2023; accordingly, its prices increased sharply. With regard to tuna, a decline in the prices of raw material revived demand for canned tuna, as processors were able to offer lower price levels.

Meanwhile, logistics problems continue to be experienced for shipments of cargo through both the Panama and Suez Canals. It should be noted that the World Container Index (WCI), which decreased by 20 percent between February 2024 and March 2024 to USD 3 160, is USD 1 300 higher than the level in March 2023. In the long run, this is expected to result in higher prices of seafood such as tilapia, pangasius, hake, and shrimp.

The Euro area annual inflation rate was 2.8 percent in January 2024, down from 2.9 percent in December 2023. Comparatively, a year earlier, the rate was 8.6 percent. European Union annual inflation was 3.1 percent in January 2024, down from 3.4 percent in December 2023. In this European Fish Price Report, 48 percent of the prices did not change compared with February 2024, with some rises noted for 27 percent of seafood products and declines for 25 percent.




## GROUNDFISH

Haddock catches in 2024 are expected to be about 265 000 tonnes, on par with the 2023 total, but 30 000 tonnes less than in 2022. Quotas for this species are lower in the Barents Sea, which will lead to reduced catches by Norway and the Russian Federation. Iceland, on the contrary, is expected to catch more haddock this year, with the total harvest estimated at 74 000 tonnes, some 12 000 tonnes more than in 2023. Prices are expected to stay stable.

There is a strong increase in the Russian pollock total allowable catch (TAC) for 2024, some 12 percent more than in previous years. In addition, the Alaska pollack TAC for the Russian Federation is more than two million tonnes, some 410 000 tonnes ahead of the 2022–2023 TAC. The US catch will be stable in 2024, at some 1.5 million tonnes. Both countries are the main producers of this species, but the main processor is China. Alaska pollack is important for Europe, as it feeds the sophisticated value-added processing industries in Germany and in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

Demand is strong for cured cod from Norway, due to the approaching Holy Week and also the cold weather which finally started in southern Europe. At the same time, it is reported that cod fish has reached the Lofoten area in Norway, which will result in higher catches and lower prices for the species.




## TUNA - BILLFISHES

Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean (WCPO) remains at a moderate level due to bad weather and strong currents. Bangkok Port continues to be congested with several carriers waiting at anchorage for berth space. Reportedly, some smaller canneries are out of raw material as their cargo are on carriers that are waiting in line. With ample supplies of raw material, skipjack prices continue to decrease while the output of finished goods has risen.


Catches in the Indian Ocean also remain moderate. In line with the same trend mentioned above, skipjack prices have continued to fall in Bangkok. Yellowfin prices are steady, with continuous demand from European buyers.

Meanwhile, the 72-day closure period for the use of Fish Aggregating Devices (FADs) in the Atlantic Ocean by the International Commission for the Conservation of Atlantic Tunas (ICCAT) ended on 13 March 2024. Catches were reported to be poor in that duration and fishers are now looking forward to some improvement in the second half of March. Similar to the price trend in the Indian Ocean, skipjack price levels are declining while yellowfin prices remain stable.


### TUNA - Pacific Ocean

### TUNA - Loins




## TUNA – BILLFISHES (cont.)

There are no changes in the situation in the Eastern Pacific Ocean. Fishing remains good, especially in Peruvian waters and raw material inventories at local canneries remain healthy. Despite this, the demand for raw material remains high due to improvements in finished goods sales. Skipjack and yellowfin prices are stable.

European market prices for both skipjack and yellowfin have fallen, while those for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins remain steady.

### TUNA - Spanish canneries




## CEPHALOPODS

The octopus season in Eastern Indonesia is nearing its end, and in anticipation, demand for the species is high. Traders are trying to increase their inventories during this period, considering the sustained high demand and potential future scarcity of stock. The price of octopus has been stable throughout the first quarter of 2024. Despite the post-holiday market showing a slight uptick, the overall trend suggests a potential downtrend in octopus prices if demand starts to decline, as it is normal at this time of the year in the European market.

Squid prices were stable in the starting months of 2024, with some higher demand for large squid. It is expected that prices will go up in view of Easter sales. Already now, South African squid sells at about EUR 1.00 per kg higher than a month ago.


### SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa





## CRUSTACEANS

Present demand for Argentine shrimp is high, due to the upcoming Holy Week. As production is low in Argentina, especially in the freezing plants on-shore, prices for the finished products are going up. Cold storage holdings in Europe are low.



This March, the Indonesian shrimp market remains stable. Prices are up for large vannamei shrimp across Indonesia during week nine of 2024 while those for smaller sizes are unchanged. Meanwhile, the trend observed in the United States of America, being the largest market for Indonesian shrimp, reflects a similar demand scenario as in previous months. Following a significant price decrease caused by over-supply, market recovery is expected to be slow. Prices for larger sizes remain relatively stagnant, while there is a notable demand for smaller sizes. The Chinese market continues its aggressive pursuit of lower prices, potentially putting Ecuador at a competitive disadvantage if the situation persists. Notably, smaller-sized shrimp has seen increased demand.

## BIVALVES


In Italy, clam production fell drastically in 2023 as compared to the average levels of 30 000 tonnes annually in prior years, due to predation by invasive blue crab. Output will continue to be severe this year, with an anticipated 70 percent drop, putting 3 000 jobs at risk. The forecast is expected to remain gloomy for 2025 and 2026 considering the absence of seed, which is also predated upon by the blue crab. In terms of value, the Goro and Scardovari Consortia estimate losses of at least EUR 120 million in production alone, while the impact cost on the entire supply chain is estimated at EUR 400–500 million.

## BIVALVES (cont.)

In the most-affected Scardovari area, the harvest of clams in December 2023 was 160 quintals, compared to the average, in the last ten years, of 12 000-15 000 quintals. Very recently, the Consortia officially announced that it had suspended fishing activities until a date to be determined. More than 3 200 fishers between Goro, Comacchio and Scardovari have been left without income, and the situation is no better among the companies that market the product, causing them to lay off their employees. Prices of clam (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) thus reached a record high of EUR 19.90 per kg.

The voracity of the blue crab has resulted in clams being sown at a minimum level, and nurseries have been installed for defensive purposes. Reports published last year, which had presented the blue crab as a commercial opportunity, are no longer convincing; according to studies presented by the University of Palermo, only 20 percent of the blue crab consists of edible meat.




## SMALL PELAGICS

Prices of herring fillets from Norway have been volatile since the start of the year, dropping and re-bounding fast, and ending at a very high level in March 2024. The present price is USD 2.00 per kg, some six percent ahead of the February price level.


Landings of mackerel in Norway during the first three months of this year were lower by 20 percent when compared with the same period the previous year. This resulted in slow but steady increases in mackerel export prices.

## FRESHWATER


The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has become a major importer of frozen pangasius fillets, mainly coming from Viet Nam. In 2023, some 15 000 tonnes of this product were imported, which is 1 000 tonnes more than in 2022 and 2 000 tonnes more than in 2021. The value of imports stayed stable at USD 48 million, showing that the unit price declined somewhat in 2023.



## SALMON

The strong growth in the value of salmon was one of the drivers that contributed to the record-high Norwegian seafood export value in February 2024, according to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC). The institution explained that the value of Norwegian seafood exports has now increased every month for the past three years, a trend which has never happened before.

Norway exported 78 522 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 9.1 billion in February 2024, which represented a decline of three percent in terms of volume but an increase of five percent in value compared with the same month of last year. Poland, Denmark and France were the largest markets during this period. According to the NSC, there was great variation in the development of the different product categories for salmon last month, and the share of fillets has never been higher. In terms of value, fillets and other processed salmon products accounted for 30 percent of exports.



## SALMON (cont.)

According to Seafood Source, based on the Nasdaq Salmon Index, the average per-kilogram price of Norwegian salmon (fresh, head-on gutted Atlantic salmon) in the eighth week of 2024, reached NOK 116.69 (EUR 10.17) compared to NOK 108.52 (EUR 9.46) in the previous week, which meant an increase of 7.53 percent. In addition, the Index reported that the average per-kilogram price had increased by NOK 11.27 (EUR 0.98) over the preceding four weeks.


## TROUT

Norway exported 4 767 tonnes of trout worth NOK 454 million in February 2024, representing an outstanding growth of 62 percent in terms of volume and 40 percent in value compared to the second month of last year. The three most important markets in February 2024 were Ukraine, the United States of America, and Thailand. Exports of fresh whole trout increased in volume by 118 percent to 3 457 tonnes, while fresh fillets decreased by 15 percent to 368 tonnes. In addition, frozen fillets registered a decline of 58 percent, to 67 tonnes.

## SEABREAM/SEABASS

The market for seabass and seabream remains tight in the early months of 2024, largely in line with expectations as trade in both species normally slows during the winter off-season. The subdued demand in recent months has been complemented by low harvests of seabream, leading to a notable strengthening in prices by 14 percent between January–March (Spanish wholesale, all grades). Following the

disappointingly low prices that were seen for seabream throughout much of 2023, farmers hope that they will see sustained price gains in the coming months as harvests start to pick up, typically from the end of March onwards. Seabass prices are stable, maintaining the high levels seen towards the end of 2023.



## SEABREAM/SEABASS (cont.)

Croatia has, in recent years, emerged as an increasingly important player in European seabass and seabream production, consistently adding production capacity. Much of this growth is associated with one company, Cromaris, which harvests approximately 13 000 tonnes of fish per year and exports the majority of production to Italy for consumption. Croatian production reached an estimated 16 000 tonnes in 2023, with production equally split between seabass and seabream. This figure is expected to rise to 20 000 tonnes in 2024.
