Shortlist for top Fundraising Shop of the Year Award as part of the National Fish & Chip Awards 2013 announced

The finalists in the Top Fundraising Shop of the Year Award as part of The National Fish & Chip Awards 2013, sponsored by Seafish, the authority on seafood, have been announced.

Shortlisted shops are: The Quayside, Whitby, The Merchant Fish Bar, Bewdley and Burton Road Fish & Chips, Lincoln. Finalists will now be invited to the glitzy final award ceremony at the prestigious Lancaster London hotel in London on 24 January 2013, where the overall winner will be crowned. This year marks the 25th anniversary of the awards, making the event even more special and each award title hotly contested.

The award recognises shops that raised significant funds for fishermen in need as part of the Seafarers UK Fish and Chip Feast event in October 2012. The week-long Fish & Chip Feast event supported by Seafish encouraged fish and chip shops and restaurants across the country to raise money for the welfare of fishermen and other seafarers in need, and their families who have fallen on hard times.

Seafarers UK's Director General Commodore Barry Bryant said: "We are delighted that fish and chip shops supported Seafarers UK by taking part in the Fish & Chip Feast.
