SEA FISHERIES All fish and shellfish landings (live weight) into Welsh ports (2016)

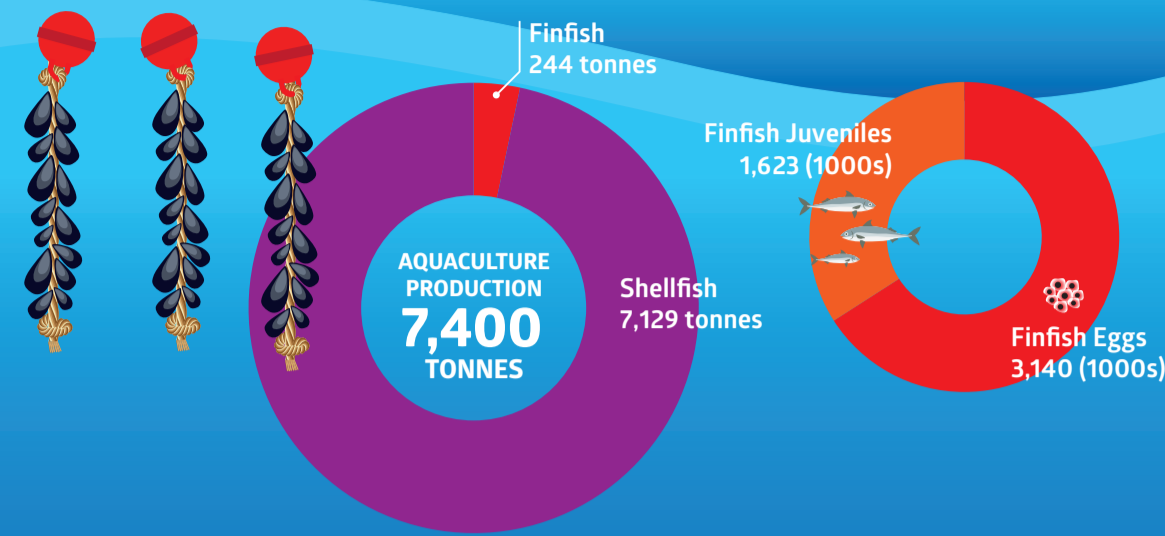


TOTAL SEAFOOD SUPPLY

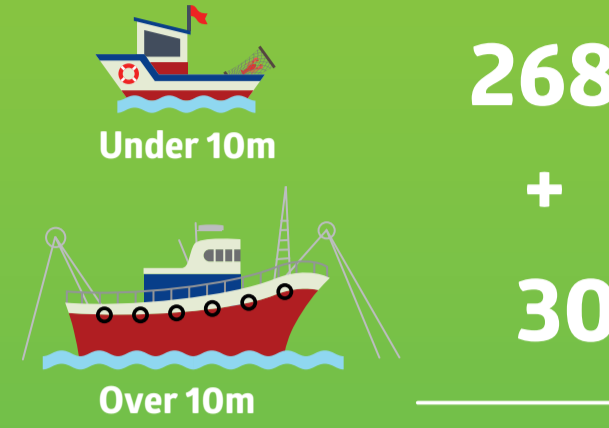

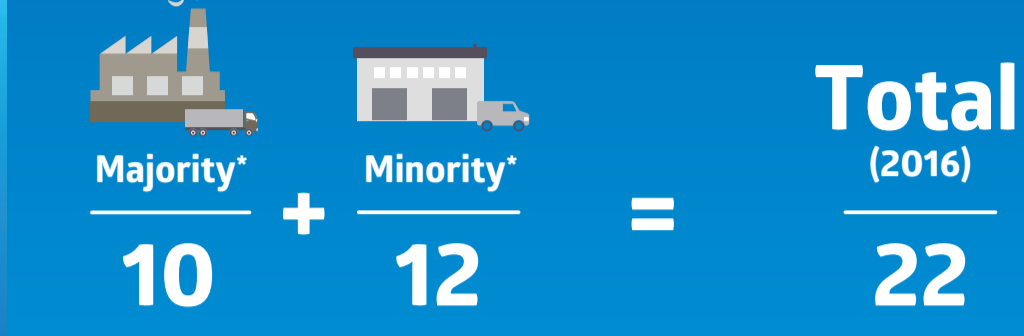

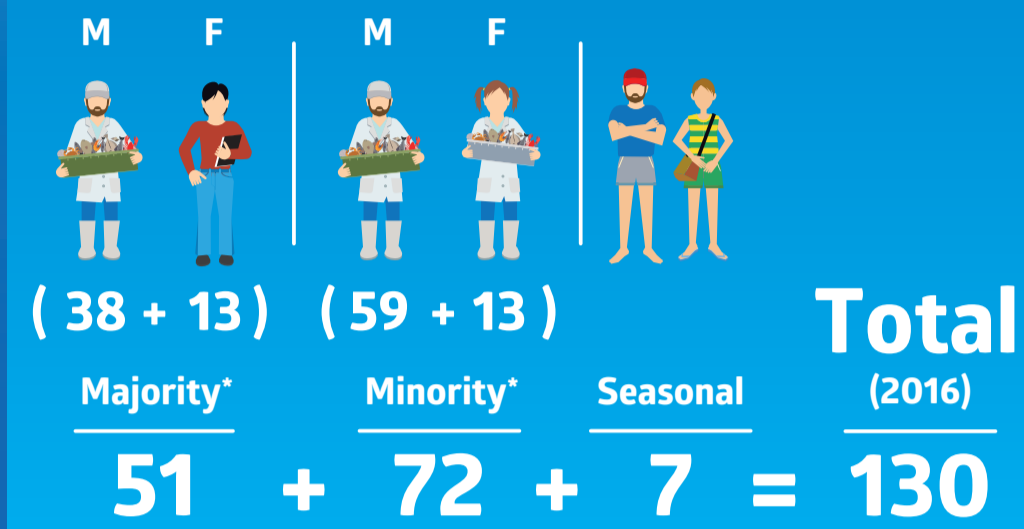

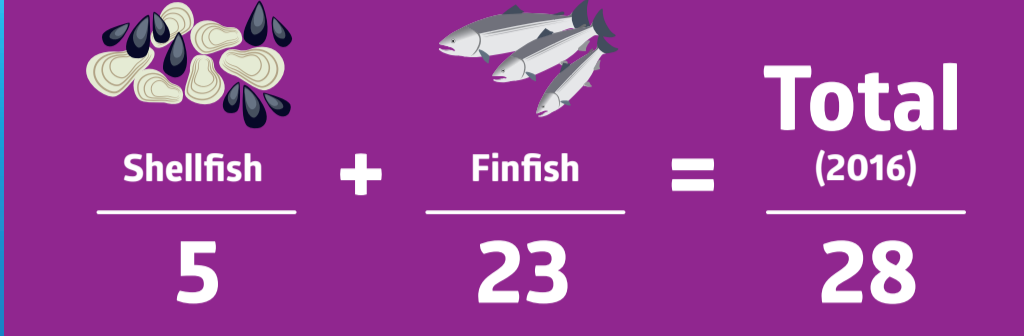
PROCESSING NUMBER OF PROCESSORS



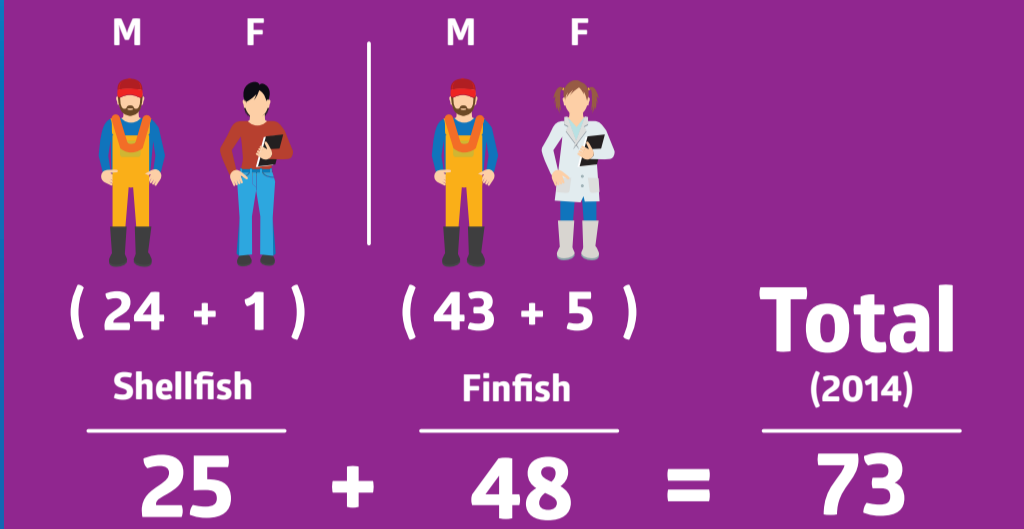
NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES



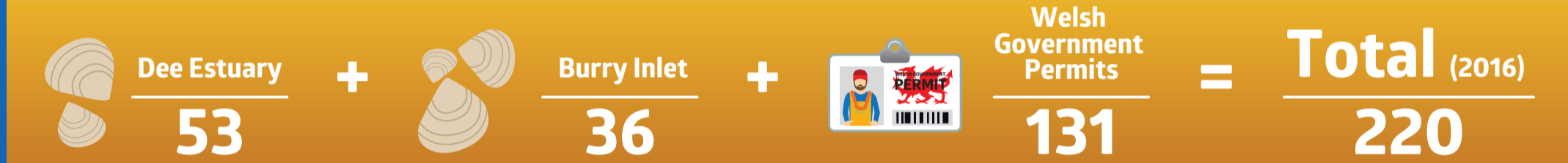

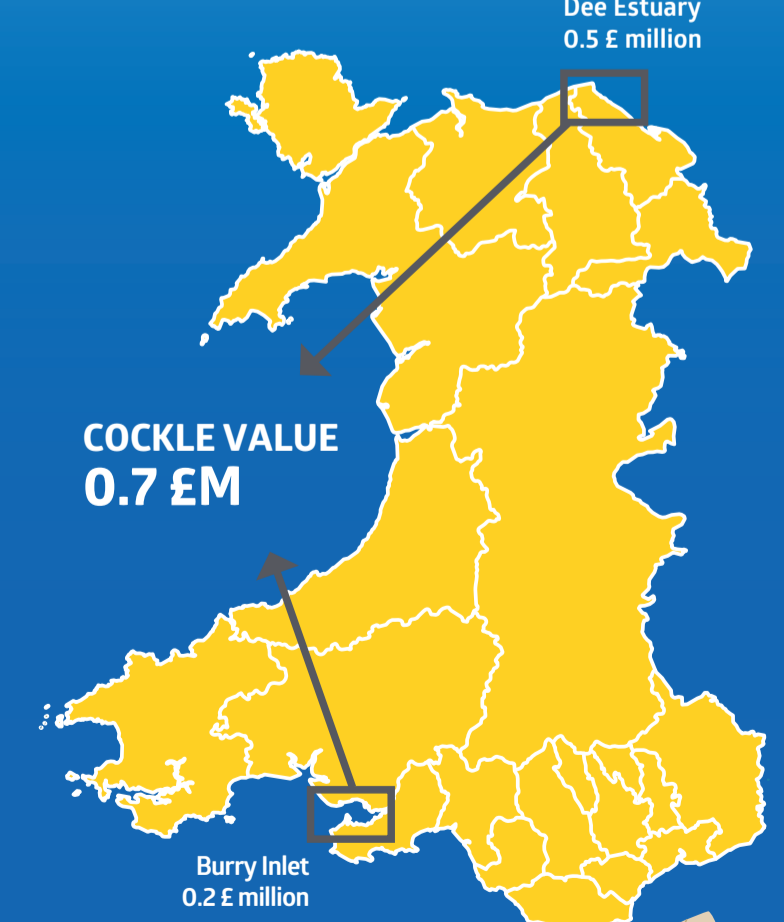
